Loch Moy Farm Events

Loch Moy Farm is proud to host a dynamic lineup of equestrian competitions throughout the year, attracting thousands of riders, owners, and spectators from across the region. Our events provide exceptional opportunities for sponsor exposure in the heart of the Mid-Atlantic equestrian community.

Each June, Loch Moy Farm hosts its marquee event - the **Maryland International CCI & Horse Trials** - featuring FEI levels from CCI-S 1* through 4*, alongside national divisions from Training through Advanced. This prestigious event is a highlight of the competition calendar and includes the ticketed Highland Club and the 2026 Young Rider Championship, drawing top emerging talent and making it a prime marketing opportunity for sponsors targeting the next generation of elite riders.

The Farm hosts the USEA recognized **Maryland Horse Trials II** in July and the **Maryland Horse Trials III** in October. These two events offer national divisions from Starter through Intermediate, drawing over 350+ riders each weekend. These popular competitions offer wide exposure to an engaged equestrian audience.

The **MDHT Highland Series Horse Trials** is a series of six unrecognized horse trials, culminating in a Championship in November. Divisions from Lead Line through Preliminary are offered and each competition draws 300+ riders. Each event includes dressage, show jumping, and cross-country, with Championship qualification requirements ensuring high-caliber participation.

The **Bred to Event Classic** is a unique competition that celebrates the breeding of top-quality event horses, with special distinctions for Maryland Bred, Thoroughbred, and US Bred horses. The Championship gives breeders and owners a platform to showcase their vision, investment, and horsemanship.

In the sandbox, there are six **USDF Recognized Dressage Shows** plus the creative “**Pick Your Time, Pick Your Test**” **Dressage and Blue Ribbon Show Jump Rounds**, where riders schedule rides at their convenience. These popular schooling events offer a flexible, low stress show experience that appeals to a broad base of competitors.

Fun and relaxed, **Twilight Eventing** runs from Introductory through Modified divisions and is ideal for young horses or riders aiming to move up a level. Events are scheduled backward from dusk with multiple dressage rings set up. The events offer full horse trials, combined tests, and dressage only classes.

Held on all-weather TRUTEX footing, **XDerbies** are innovative competitions combining cross country obstacles (banks, water, ditches) and show jump elements from cross rails to Modified. There is a schooling session prior to each division.
