Young horses from yearlings to five-year-old's will compete on a qualifying day and at each level the top 10 will move forward to the championships the following day. The schedule and definition of classes are as followed:

Thursday, September 28

Class 1. Yearling In Hand Qualifier

Class 2. Two-Year-Old In Hand Qualifier

Class 3. Three-Year-Old In Hand Qualifier

Horses will be judged in hand for their conformation and walk. Then they will be turned loose in the jump chute to judge the trot and canter. Must score at least a 7.5 in conformation to be eligible for the next day Championships.

Friday September 29

Class 4. Yearling In Hand Championships---the top 10 from Thursday to qualify.

Horses will be judged by 2 championship judges on their gaits using the same format as the qualifier. The Conformation score will carry over from their previous day and scores added to place the winner.

Class 5. Two Year Olds In Hand Championships--the top 10 from Thursday to qualify.

Horses will be judged by 2 championship judges on their gaits using the same format as the qualifier. The Conformation score will carry over from their previous day and scores added to place the winner.

Class 6. Three Year Old Championships--the top 10 from Thursday to qualify.

Horses will show themselves over the jumps in the jump chute. (See rules for jumping specifications.) The previous days movement and conformation scores will carry over and be added to the jumping score to determine the winner.

Saturday September 30

Class 7A. Four Year Old Qualifier A-- (for 4 year old horses that are not ready to do XC jumps. Their Championship day jumping will be free schooled in the jump chute).

Horses will be shown under saddle in small groups for basic gaits. At the end of the class they will remove the tack and be judged for conformation. Must score at least a 7.5 in conformation to be eligible for the next day Championships.

Class 7B. Four Year Old Qualifier B—(for those 4 year olds who have more experience in jumping under saddle)

Horses will be judged for conformation near the barns. Afterwards they will be ridden in small groups Under Saddle to show basic gaits. After that they will jump a short Derby course and finish with an open gallop. Must score at least a 7.5 in conformation to be eligible for the next day Championships.

Class 8. Five Year Olds Qualifier

Horses will be judged for conformation near the barns. Afterwards they will be ridden in small groups Under Saddle to show basic gaits. After that they will jump a short Derby course and finish with an open gallop. Must score at least a 7.5 in conformation to be eligible for the next day Championships.

Sunday October 1

Class 9A. Four Year Old Championship A--the top 10 from Class 7A to qualify.

Horses will be judged by 2 Championship judges over fences in the Jump Chute. The previous days movement and conformation scores will carry over and will be added to the jumping score to determine the winner.

Class 9B. Four Year Old Championship B--the top 10 from Class 7B, who jumped the short Derby course on Saturday.

Horses will do a short dressage test, and then do a longer Derby course, with an Open Gallop at the end of the course.

Class 10. Five Year old Championship--the top 10 from Class 8.

Horses will do a short dressage test, and then do a longer Derby course, with an Open Gallop at the end of the course.
